- To create a space to reflect on and explore the personal narrative and experience of being a teacher.
- To grow the capacity of individuals to teach, challenge and transform.
- To situate that experience within the wider arc of the teacher and the leader in the Catholic school
- To develop basic habits and insights to sustain and grow the spirituality of each teacher
- To introduce skills and perspectives towards post-critical belief.

### Youth Formation

- Year 11 & 12 Leadership Formation Program: This program will be offered to Year 11 and 12 student leaders in BCE and RI schools. It will consist of a large gathering at the start of Term 2 to empower the leaders to live out their mission with joyful hope and conclude with a smaller gathering in Term 3 for students who would like to delve deeper.

The Power of TEN To Inspire and Lead (PoTENtial) is designed to empower and inspire Year 10 students to use their God given gifts and talents to make a difference in the world. It is a day full of prayer, music, inspiring keynotes and workshops and includes our partners Vinnies Youth, Caritas and Catholic Mission.

#### - 5/6 Formation Days with Year 8-10 Leaders

The Year 5/6 Formation days have provided meaningful opportunities of encounter as the secondary students have shown themselves to be great examples to the younger students in welcoming, sharing their story and praying with them.

#### THCT605 – An Introduction to the Catholic Dialogue Schools Project (ACU & BCE) BCE07738
