Jesus came down with them and stood on a level place, with a great crowd of his disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea, Jerusalem, and the coast of Tyre and Sidon.

WE REFLECT

(Challenge: find the locations mentioned in the scripture above on the map!)

The verse from the Gospel of Luke mentions that on this particular day, a great crowd of people gathered with Jesus,

ready to hear Him speak. Ordinarily this Gospel passage includes Jesus teaching the disciples about the Beatitudes. Later this week come back together as a class and keep reading the rest of the passage (Luke 20-26) so you can hear and reflect on what Jesus said. But for now, let's focus on who was listening.

What is interesting, is that the people who gathered to hear Him speak were from very different places. Each person who listened to Jesus on this day had a different family, a different culture, some even had different languages that they could speak. But all of them were gathered together because of their interest in listening to Jesus.

What do you have in common with those around you? What makes you unique? Despite your differences, how can you show compassion and love to everyone you meet?
