

## **WE REFLECT**

Many people would believe that the secret to life is being a good person. In this passage from Luke's gospel, Jesus calls His followers to a higher level of living. He invites those listening to His teaching to love all people, not just those who agree with us, not just our friends we play with, but also our "enemies". Jesus doesn't say that the bad things our enemies might do is okay, but He asks us to show them love anyway. After all, God created everyone – even our enemies. Some year 3 students told me once, "You don't have to be friends with everyone, but you do have to be friendly to everyone". I think they understood what Jesus was saying in the passage that we read. Jesus' words are designed to help us live more like Him. Everyone can be nice to their friends, but it is a lot more challenging to show love to all people, even those who hate us!

Have a think about how Jesus' teaching might change the way you treat the people at school.

How can you show love to everyone – even your enemies? Try choosing to be kind to that person who is mean to you. Or forgiving someone who has hurt you. When someone is mean or hateful, be kind and loving in return.
