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

### Year One

#### **Year Level Description**

*Identify* words, actions and symbols used in the Sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist to communicate God's presence and action.

They explore the words, actions and symbols used in the Sacraments of Baptism and <u>Eucharist</u> to communicate God's presence and action. They learn about the different roles in the local parish community

#### **Achievement Standard**

They identify words, actions and symbols used in the Sacraments of Baptism and <u>Eucharist</u> to communicate God's presence and action.

### Year Two

**Make** connections between Jesus' teachings and actions and the way members of the Church community live today.

*Make* connections between Jesus' healing ministry and the Church community's celebration of the Sacrament of Penance.

#### **Year Level Description**

They develop their understanding of the loving relationship God unconditionally offers to people; and their understanding of <u>sin</u>, as evident in the free choices that harm the individual and their loving relationships with God, with others and with all creation. They explore ways in which believers seek to heal these relationships through reconciliation and prayer. They investigate ways in which believers celebrate reconciliation with God and with others in the Sacrament of Penance.

#### **Achievement Standard**

They make connections between Jesus' healing ministry and the Church community's celebration of the Sacrament of Penance.

### **Year Three**

#### Year Level Description

They learn about the significance of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, <u>Eucharist</u>) for the Church community.

#### Achievement Standard

They explain ways in which the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, <u>Eucharist</u>) welcome and strengthen members of the Church community.

**Demonstrate** an understanding of the significance of the Church community. **Explain** ways that the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) welcome and strengthen the members of the Church community.





### **Year Four**

#### Year 4 Level Description

They broaden their understanding of the significance of the Sacraments for Church communities through an exploration of the Sacraments of Healing, including Anointing of the Sick and Penance.

#### Year 4 Achievement Standard

They demonstrate an understanding of how the celebrations of Anointing of the Sick and Penance continue Jesus' mission and ministry in the life of the community.

**Explain** how practices and characteristics of contemporary parishes and diocese are modelled on the mission and ministry of Jesus. Demonstrate an understanding about how the Sacraments of Anointing of the Sick and Penance continue Jesus' mission and ministry in the life of the community.



### **Year Five**

#### Year Level Description

They learn about the action of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers as they engage with a variety of texts, including Scriptural references to the Holy Spirit and the Catholic Rite of Confirmation.

#### Achievement Standard

Students explain the action of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers. They analyse information from a variety of texts including Scriptural references to the Holy Spirit and the words, symbols and actions of the Catholic Rite of Confirmation.

**Explain** the action of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers.

**Analyse** information from a variety of texts including Scriptural references to the Holy Spirit.



### **Year Six**

#### Year Level Description

They develop their understanding of the role of celebrations in the faith life of believers, including the commemoration of High Holy Days by Jewish believers and the Church's liturgical celebrations (including the Eucharist).

#### Achievement Standard

They identify and describe many ways in which faith is celebrated in the lives of believers, past and present, including the commemoration of High Holy Days by Jewish believers; the Church's liturgical year and the celebration of <u>Eucharist</u>

**Identify** and describe many ways in which faith is <u>celebrated</u> in the lives of believers past and present.

*Identify* and *describe* the Church's liturgical year and the celebration of Eucharist.



### **Year Seven**

#### Year Level Description

Students examine ways in which believers nurture their spiritual life through prayer, ritual, the sacraments and sacred texts.

#### Achievement Standard

Students evaluate and draw conclusions about the significance of prayer, ritual, sacraments and sacred texts for the faith journey of believers, personally and communally.

### **Year Eight**

#### Year Level Description

They learn about the significance of initiation rituals in the Abrahamic religions (Christianity, Judaism, Islam) for the faith journey of believers.

#### Achievement Standard

They identify the significance of initiation rituals in the Abrahamic religions (Judaism, Christianity, Islam) for the faith journey of believers.

**Identify** the significance of initiation rituals in the Abrahamic religions (Judaism, Christianity, Islam) for the faith journey of believers.

### **Year Nine**

Year Level Description

**Evaluate** and **draw conclusions** about the significance of the celebration of the Sacraments of Healing (Penance and Anointing of the Sick) in the lives of believers past and present.



They consider sources of inspiration, strength and guidance for believers today, including Catholic social teaching, the three forms of penance (prayer, fasting and <u>almsgiving</u>), <u>Scripture</u>, celebration of the Sacraments of Healing (Penance and Anointing of the Sick), and personal and communal prayer experiences.

#### Achievement Standard

They evaluate and draw conclusions about the three forms of penance (prayer, fasting and almsgiving) and the celebration of the Sacraments of Healing (Penance and Anointing of the Sick), in the lives of believers past and present. **Consider** the significance of various sources that nourish the spiritual life of believers.

Year Ten

### Year Level Description

**Consider** how the following sources nourish the spiritual life of believers:

- Eucharist
- Prayer of St Francis,
- Magnificat
- Canticle of Creation,
- contemplative prayer,
- centering prayer
- meditative prayer especially Lectio of Nature

and evaluate their relevance for a modern Australian context.



They examine the <u>Eucharist</u> as the primary and indispensable source of nourishment for the spiritual life of believers, who carry on Jesus' mission in the world.

#### Achievement Standard

Students consider the significance of various sources that nourish the spiritual life of believers including; the Eucharist, the Peace Prayer of St Francis, The Magnificat, the Canticle of Creation, contemplative prayer, centering prayer and meditative prayer including Lectio of Nature and individual and communal prayer for justice, peace and the environment.
