



## **The Reconceptualist Appoach**

- Three considerations (pp 24 27):
  - Avoidance of presumptive language
  - Teaching 'about' the tradition
  - Powerful pedagogies

• Dialogue

- Post-critical belief
  - (participate critically and authentically in faith contexts)
