## RESOURCES

Each person will be given a laminated card. It will be from one of the 4 categories:

1. Historical period dot points (8 cards) - key dates, names and scriptures
2. Description of historical period in prose (8 cards)
3. Key events from that period (8 cards)
4. Scripture written during that period (8 cards).

## ACTIVITY

You will be given a laminated card from one of the 4 categories listed above.

1. Find the matching cards from the other three categories for the same historical period
2. Once you have all four cards for the historical period, form a group and become experts in that period
3. Line up in a human timeline with spacing to match distance in years between each period
4. Share your expertise on that period with the group.

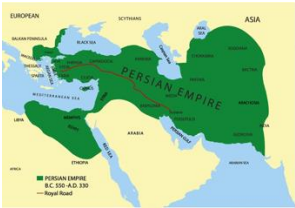
