#### FINDING THE RIGHT LICENCE

##### Determining which licence is needed for liturgical music copyright:




[Licence - Smartcopying](#)

The majority of uses by schools of Christian liturgical music will be covered by the national schools' music licences. (APRA/AMCOS) Schools will only need an additional [licence](#) with CCLI or OneLicense if they want to:

- do an activity that is not covered by the national schools music licences
- use [musical works](#) from the small number of composers/publishers that are not covered by the national schools licences (ie the song(s) is not a part of the [APRA AMCOS](#) repertoire).

An example of an activity not covered by the national schools licences is displaying lyrics at events (eg assemblies, school worship services) where people other than the staff and students are in attendance. For example, in a parish mass where the school is providing lyrics for hymns.

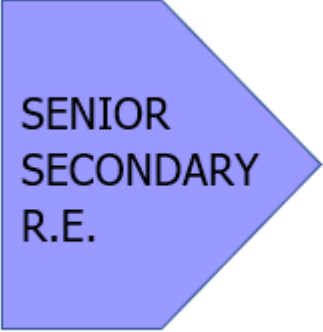
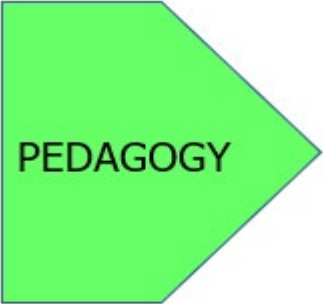
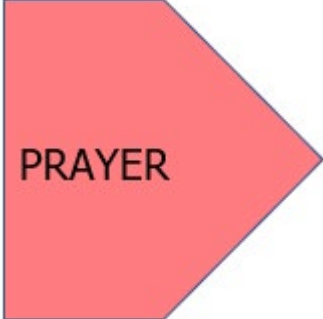
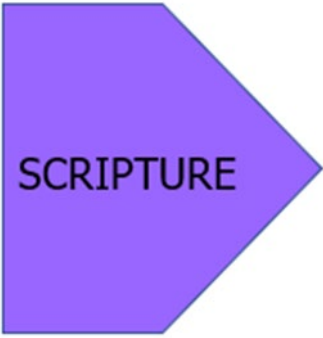
