

## Definition

*A sin is any act that is morally wrong. A sin is when someone chooses to deliberately break a religious or moral rule. A sin is when a person chooses to do something harmful to others in full knowledge that it is harmful.*

*In the bible, the word for 'sin' originally meant 'to miss a target'.*

- deliberate
- done on purpose
- morally wrong (bad consequences)
- hurts people (harmful to people or to the environment)
