Religious ideas in horror films

The supernatural assumes the possibility and reality of miracles.

- What is considered normal for a supernatural force is considered a miracle by those of us limited to the natural world.

Christian Beliefs

 The Christian Church is built upon a series of core supernatural beliefs. These are the incarnation, resurrection and ascension of Jesus into heaven.

God and the Devil

- ➤ If God raised Jesus from the dead to save us from sin and evil, then, does evil have a particular name? According to many Christians, the source of sin and evil in the world is the devil.
- ➤ If one believes in God then must the devil exist as his arch-enemy. Read the story of Jesus being tempted by the devil in the wilderness in

Nature of God and the Devil

- Are both God and the Devil a presence or is God a presence while the devil is an absence? For example think of a candle.
- When the candle is lit there is a presence of light (God) when the candle is extinguished there is an absence of light (the devil).
- Is the devil then, a pointer or symbol of God's absence rather than some entity in its own right? How does this fit with St Matthew's 4:1-11?

Heaven, Purgatory and Hell

 Pope John Paul II pointed out that the essential characteristic of heaven, hell or purgatory is that they are states of being of a spirit (angel/demon) or human soul, rather than places, as commonly perceived and represented in human language.
